

What to Bring to Dress Rehearsal and Recital:

Our show day is quickly approaching! So, it is time to start preparing what to bring to the Dress Rehearsal and Recital!

1) Costumes!!

- a. Students should be sent in costume/in their first costume if they have multiple. All costume pieces should be neatly packed and **LABELED!**
- b. Make sure you have the correct tights, socks, shoes, and accessories packed as well! If you would like, you can send extra undergarments, tights, or clothes in case of an emergency!

2) Hair/Makeup Bag!

- a. If your child is going to need their hair done or touched up, please be sure to send them with their own hair supplies. Including a brush, hairspray, hair ties, bobby pins, a donut bun if they use one, and so on.
- b. This applies to makeup as well (if your child is permitted to wear any for the show).

3) Water and Snacks!

- a. Please send your child with a labeled water bottle to the dress rehearsal and the recital, first and last name!
- b. “Clean Snacks” only! AKA nothing that can stain a costume. Pretzels and goldfish are perfect, but I wouldn’t suggest yogurts or anything sticky! **We are asking to bring only NUT FREE snacks!**
- c. If your child has a food allergy, please be sure to label their snacks as such. You can also email ahead of time to amarchese@lynbrookvillage.com, so I will make a note of any child with food allergies for the classroom chaperones.

4) Something to Do!

- a. We will be bringing coloring books and toys, but it is never a bad idea to pack extra! Especially for dress rehearsal as they will be sitting for an extended period of time. This can include Ipads and so on.
